





#### Euro Area New Bank Loans under €1 million as % of GDP



### European programmes – 4 types

#### **Subsidies administered by the European Commission**

- thematic - research, innovation, environment, transport, energy, etc.

#### **European subsidies administered jointly with MS and regions**

- regional aid - structural fonds (ERDF, ESF)

## Direct actions supporting internationalisation and promotion of entrepreneurship

- Entrepreneurship 2020

**Access to finance** (loan guarantees, risk capital, credits) administered by the EIB, and made available by national intermediaries
